Berlin is currently at the forefront of the world's art scene working as an axis of contemporary creativity and production. Berlin is the city where new dynamics of current art are unleashed and future




aesthetics are established. Located in the thriving neighborhood of Friedrichshain, the nerve center of Berlin's Art District.


